### **Creating a Roadmap for Innovation and Change**

- 1. Define the opportunity
- Identify why it matters to your organization ("So What" compelling need)
- 3. Create Action Plan for Implementation
- 4. Develop support and commitment (who needs to buy off)
- 5. Manage the CHANGE and transition (for everyone impacted)

### 10 Lessons from Innovative Leaders

- Improve upon what already exists. (Don't confuse innovation with invention)
- 2. Create clear goals / vision for the future
- 3. See the bigger picture; expand your world view
- Focus more on your "users" (WHO you serve) than your products / policies
- 5. Be creative; stay curious
- Do what you love; passion fuels determination and perseverance
- 7. Believe in the impossible and be willing to fail
- 8. Be a "forward thinker"
- 9. Don't be afraid of change
- 10. Be persistent; success is not linear
